Greet students at door



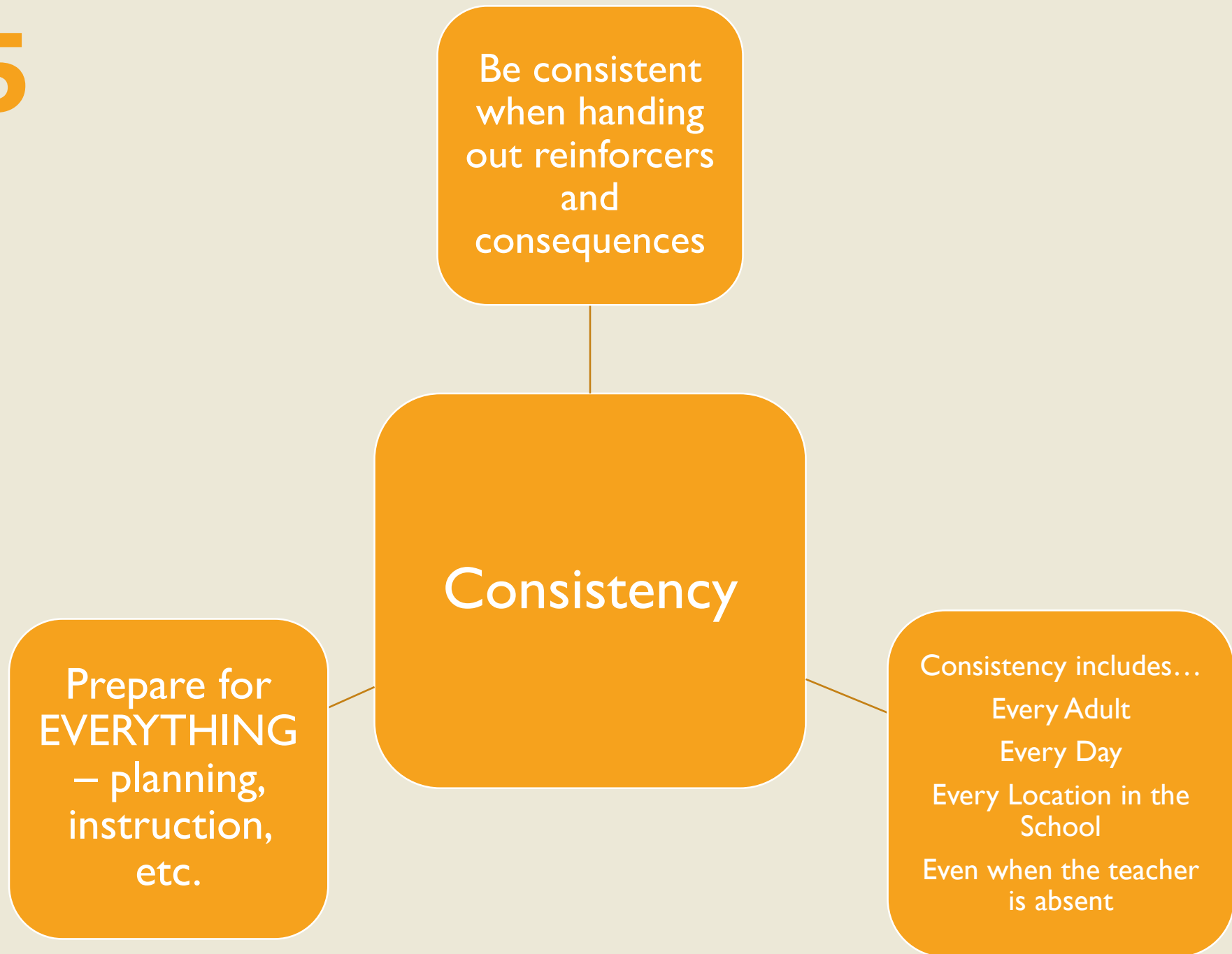
